

Instructions for Covid-19 vaccinations

Vaccinations are currently ongoing in the following locations:

- at Kuopio –hall: employees of Kuopio city and of the Kuopio concern enterprises (Kuopion Vesi, Kuopion Energia, Mestar, Servica). To be vaccinated at Kuopio hall a patient should have Kuopio or Siilinjärvi as his/her official home town
- at Siilinjärvi (Torikatu 4, 2nd floor): employees of Siilinjärvi commune, and employees of Kuopio city / Kuopio concern enterprise. Patients should have Siilinjärvi or Kuopio as their home town
- at PSSHP: employees of the hospitals of Puijo / Julkula, or Siilinjärvi / Alava psychiatric units (home town usually Kuopio/Siilinjärvi)
- at Varkaus: employees of Varkaus city

We are also ready to begin vaccinations for our private enterprise customers.

Vaccinations are being organized with the same principles as in the home town: Kuopio is now vaccinating people between the ages of 12-69 years who belong to the Covid-19 risk groups 1 and 2, and people who are older than 16 years (no requirement of belonging to a risk group).

The second covid-19 vaccine is given 12 weeks after the first dose, so please take this into account when making your summer plans! Changes in vaccinations schedules are only allowed due to medical reasons (such as cancer treatment etc.)

We can vaccinate only patients who have Kuopio / Siilinjärvi as their official home town. That is because we will have vaccines only of these towns to

use. Citizens of other home towns should have their vaccinations from there.
